

## **STARTING THE ENGINE**

- Hold the Tattletale switch down while turning the ignition key
- Release the Tattletale switch once the engine builds sufficient oil pressure.  
Note: the Tattletale switch is overriding the oil low pressure safety cut-out system. Therefore, if the Tattletale is disengaged before full oil pressure is established the safety system will automatically shut the engine down. While the Tattletale switch is employed the user is responsible for checking that the correct oil pressure is created. To avoid damaging the engine, it must have adequate oil pressure within 15 seconds of starting.
- Turn the throttle to the desired level. Do not exceed the maximum speed of 2200 RPM
- Check gauges for proper operating levels
